What you'll need

A brown paper grocery bag

If there's printing on the bag, just cut a panel from another paper bag and glue it on for a plain surface.

Construction paper

9" x 12" sheets:

Pink (2 Sheets), Black (1 Sheet),
White (1 Sheet), Orange (1 Sheet)

Scissors

Pencil

Ruler

Glue stick

Snack

(Optional)

Here we go!

Step 1

Cut out templates, and use as guides to cut all shapes from construction paper as directed.

Step 2

Prepare the paper bag

(carefully remove handles, cut eye slot, cut arm holes).

Step 3

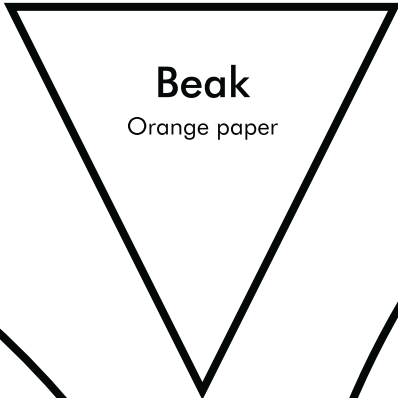
Glue all pieces together & onto the bag.

(use the image on cover as a guide)

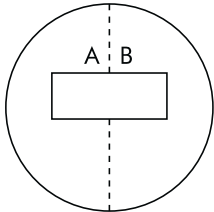

tape to Face B before tracing →



finished face should be 9" circle
cut from one piece of construction paper

Face A & B
(X2) White paper

Be sure there's plenty of space in the eye holes for your little one to see. And if your kiddo doesn't like head-covering, no problem -- just cut a hole in the top of the bag so the head can poke through. (The Wee Alpha will be on the kid's chest.)

Wings
(X 2) Pink paper
